## *Reporting on the Ministry of Wilfred Makalanzi.*



Wilfred returned to Makang'wa on December 29<sup>th</sup>. His recent mission was conducted in villages in the north west of Tanzania, on the eastern shores of Lake Victoria.

### Wilfred's Report:

Praise the Lord Jesus Christ.

Firstly, I would offer thanks to God because he was with me from the start of the trip.

I commenced my work on Dec. 9<sup>th</sup> at Kahangale, conducting a three day teaching seminar. Then on the 12<sup>th</sup>- 13<sup>th</sup> we held an outdoor evangelistic crusade. Thirty seven (37) people committed their lives to Jesus as Saviour.

We next moved to Kung'ombe Parish where I conducted a seminar on the Holy Spirit from the 14<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup>. The theme was, '*How to follow Jesus and live the Christian life in the power of the Holy Spirit.*' This was followed by a three day evangelistic crusade, 18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> December. Seventy three (73) people accepted Jesus as their Saviour.

The next place of ministry was at Ngamitwe, 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> December. There I conducted a seminar in the mornings and the crusade in the evenings. The themes were, '*How to live the Christian life in the power of the Holy Spirit*' and '*How to win over temptation*'. About 370 people attended and 175 accepted Jesus as Saviour.

### **Wilfred's Ministry Program for 2016.**

- (a) January 19<sup>th</sup> to February 7<sup>th</sup>. Ruvuma Region. This takes him back to Mbinga where last year many local Muslims responded to the Gospel. There is joy when Muslims come to know the truth about Jesus. Of course, they have heard of him, but in a most limited manner. Bibles are needed urgently!
- (b) April 10<sup>th</sup> to May 1<sup>st</sup>. Mbeya Region, southern highlands. He will be mainly in the Ileya area, near lake Nyassa.
- (c) July 5<sup>th</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup>. Ministry in the Gieta Region, near Rawanda, north west Tanzania.
- (d) October 10<sup>th</sup> to October 30<sup>th</sup>. Ministry in the Ruvuma Region, Tandura District.

This is the basic outline for the year. In every circumstance Wilfred has been invited to teach and preach. He does have a family in Makang'wa village! His wife, Selina, is active locally in children's ministry. Selina leads 200 primary children every Saturday at Children of Peace, Igondola. Truly, we do need to increase financial support for Wilfred by \$250.00 per quarter through this year.
